STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

GENERAL INFORMATION: MICROYL is a unique activator adjuvant that provides superior performance and improved turfgrass safety at lower use rates when compared to ordinary crop oil concentrates.

FOR USE WITH PESTICIDES REGISTERED FOR GOLFCOURSES, SOD FARMS, RECREATIONAL, COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL TURFGRASS AREAS, AS WELL AS SPORTS GRASS PLAYING SURFACES AND NON-CROPLAND.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: The addition of adjuvants to some pesticides and / or fertilizers and their tank mixes may cause phytotoxicity to the foliage and / or fruit of desirable crops. Before using MICROYL, the applicator or crops advisor must have experience with the pesticide combination, including MICROYL, or must have conducted a phytotoxicity test. Do not use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling. MICROYL increases the activity of many pesticides; therefore, care must be taken when treating sensitive crops during periods of drought stress, high temperatures or high humidity.

USE RATES

Apply at 0.375 - 0.5% v/v, (3-4 pints of MICROYL per 100 gallons of spray solution)

MIXING

In the absence of specific mixing instructions found on the pesticide label, fill the spray tank with at least 50% of the desired finished carrier volume. When premixing in a mixing vessel or inductor, fill with at least 20% of the desired finished carrier volume. While the carrier is agitating, add tank mix ingredients in the following order:

1. Compatibility agent, if needed.
2. Dry formulations (WP, DF, WDG, SP) and dry drift retardants.
3. Liquid drift retardants and flowable formulations (F and FL).
4. Microencapsulated and suspension concentrates (ME and SC).
5. Emulsifiable concentrates (E, EL or EC).
6. Solutions (S, L and LC), micronutrients, liquid or suspension fertilizers.
7. Adjuvants (COC, HSOC, MSO, NIS) and/or water conditioning agents.
8. Finish filling to desired spray volume level and continue agitation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not use, spill or store near heat or open flame. Keep container closed tightly when not in use. Prevent water from being introduced to the contents of this container. Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of container in a safe manner in accordance with federal, state and local regulations.
